

DISTRICT AWARD OF MERIT



WHAT IS IT:

The District Award of Merit is a Council Award presented by the District.

WHO CAN RECEIVE IT:

Any Scouter can be nominated for the award (unless previously awarded the DOA)

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR NOMINATION:

- A nominee must be a registered Scouter
- A nominee must have rendered noteworthy service to youth in Scouting, outside of Scouting, or both. The nature and value of “noteworthy service to youth” may consist of a single plan or decisions that contribute vitally to the lives of large numbers of youth or it may have been given to small group over an extended period of time.
- Consideration must be given to the nominee’s Scouting position and the corresponding opportunity to render outstanding service beyond the expectations of that Scouting position.
- The nominee’s attitude toward and cooperation with the District and Council is to be taken into consideration.
