

## **Crossroads Klondike Derby Information Sheet**

8:30am--8:50am Troops arrive

8:50am--9:00am Opening ceremony-flag ceremony

9:00am--12:00pm Complete Stations

12:00pm--1:00pm Lunch Time

1:00pm--3:50pm Complete stations

3:50pm--4:00pm Closing ceremony flag ceremony

If troops have a troop flag to please bring it. We will post troop flags alongside the American flag.

Troops will need to bring their own fire pit or way to contain fire used for heat and cooking.

Troops will be required to provide lunch for their scouts. Only requirement is for it to be fulfilling and every scout eats something.

Troops will need to bring some firewood and water for the day. There will be some firewood and water available to be used.

Plaques will be awarded to every troop using on a gold, silver, bronze scale based on total points earned.

There will be a traveling trophy for the troop with the most points. That troop will hold trophy for the year and come back the following year to defend it

Stations:

**Knots:** Scouts will need to tie clove hitch, bowline and 2 half hitches. Points will be awarded for the fastest and done correctly. Scouts will be able to earn bonus points by choosing another knot to tie and points will be awarded for difficulty and being done correctly. 1 point will be awarded to the top 3 fastest times for each knot. 1 point will be awarded for each knot done correctly. Points for bonus knot will be decided by instructor.

**Structure Building:** Spar poles will be provided. Troops will build a 3-legged tripod using lashings. 1 point will be awarded for each correct lashing 1 point will be awarded for sturdiness

**Fire Building:** As you get settled in and get ready to start your fires you will have 2 tasks. Burn string in half at 18in. and 24in. 1 point will be awarded to the top 3 fastest times for each height. To start you may build your fire teepee to just below 18in. string.

**Orienteering:** Find the distance between the 2 flags without measuring. Troops with the 3 closest or correct answers will get 1 point

**What's Wrong With This Campsite:** There will be a campsite set up with things that are wrong. 1 point for every wrong item identified, Troop with all items identified earns extra points

**First Aid:** There will be 2 scenarios and more information will be given at the event.

Scenario 1---Tornado victim at camp

Scenario 2---Person shoveling snow

**Engineering:** Build a structure using regular and mini marshmallows and spaghetti and skewers. Points will be awarded by instructor on design height and creativity.

**Sled Race:** Be prepared to race on snow or dry ground. 4 scouts per team 1 scout must ride on sled. There will be a course set up, during the last 20 ft all 4 scouts must carry sled points will be awarded to the top 3 times.

Some events will be held in stations around park others will be done at designated camp site.
